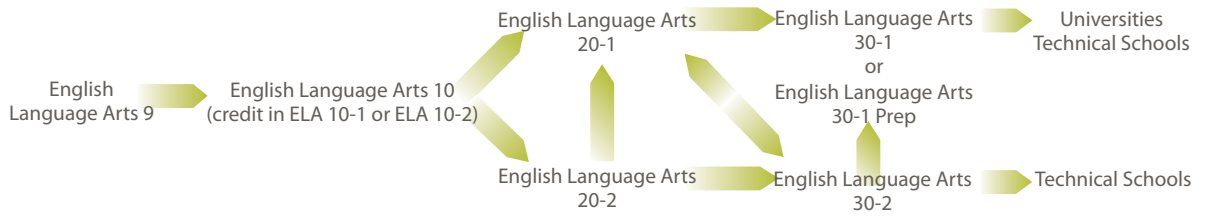

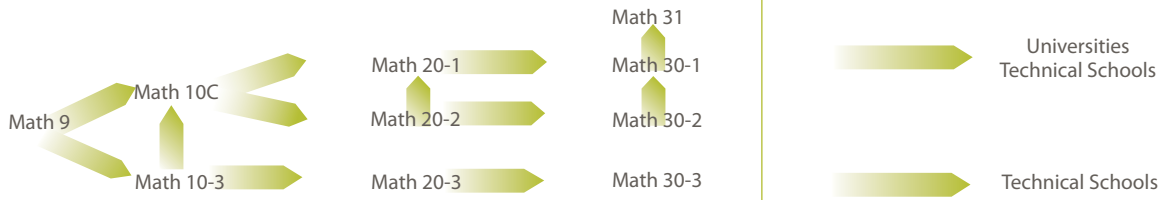

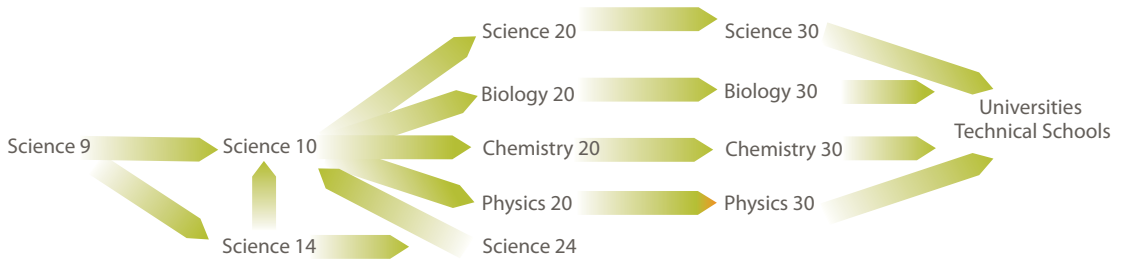

## Course, Activity & Material Fees

Fees are due at the time of registration. Waivers are not applicable.

- If paying by cheque, only one cheque is required for Course, Activity & Material Fees and the Refundable Security Deposit.

**New:** There is no course fee for students under 20 years of age as of September 1 of the current school year. Activity and Material Fees still apply to Art and Physical Education.

If you were 20 years of age or older as of September 1 of the current school year:

- 8-credit Classroom Learning daytime courses \$545
- 5-credit Classroom Learning daytime courses \$545
- 5-credit Classroom Learning evening courses \$480
- 3-credit Classroom Learning daytime courses \$355
- 3-credit Classroom Learning evening courses \$295

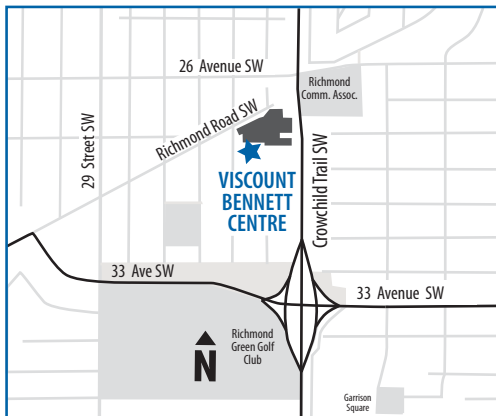
